

Wild West Challenge 12th & 13th September 2015 (“The Event”)

ShelterBox Terms & Conditions



These are the Terms and Conditions of ShelterBox.

You, as the participant acknowledge that the Event is organised by a third party (Adventure Café whose registered office is at Office 6, Frogmary Green Farm, West St, South Petherton, Somerset TA13 5DJ) with whom you have a separate agreement and its Terms and Conditions should be read in conjunction with these set out below.

It is a condition that all participants comply with both ShelterBox’s Terms and Conditions and Adventure Café’s Terms and Conditions.

1. To take part in the Event you must be 18 or over.
2. For the Event we require a registration fee, which should be enclosed with the booking forms. Unless the Event is cancelled by ShelterBox, this fee is non-refundable once you have been accepted on the Event.
3. By registering on the Event you are pledging to raise the minimum sponsorship stated in the Event details and understand that it is the aim of the Event to raise as much above this amount as possible in aid of ShelterBox.
4. The registration fee and all sponsorship money should be made payable to ShelterBox. Under no circumstances can money raised by the Event be used for another charity or organisation.
5. By registering on the Event you understand that the place has been granted to you at a cost to ShelterBox and you will collect and deliver at least the pledged amount to ShelterBox within 30 days after the Event, whether from sponsorship, or from your own resources in the event of a shortfall.
6. Should you have to withdraw at any time, all sponsorship forms and other materials should be returned to ShelterBox. If your sponsors wish for a refund of their sponsorship money, they are asked to apply in writing to ShelterBox.
7. Of the money raised, around 50 per cent of the minimum sponsorship will be used to cover the costs of Adventure Café including your transportation, accommodation, guides and back-up team.
8. You agree to raise all money using legal methods and complying with the advice given in the fundraising pack.
9. In accordance with the Charities Act you must make a solicitation statement to sponsors or potential sponsors when seeking sponsorship money as follows:

“I am fundraising on behalf of ShelterBox and I am raising sponsorship monies in order to take part in Wild West Challenge. Of the sponsorship monies which I raise, a proportion will be used to pay for my trip.”
10. Please note that the registration fee is not eligible for Gift Aid. In addition the donations of a sponsor ‘connected’ to you do not qualify for Gift Aid unless you have self-funded the trip. A ‘connected person’ is defined as: a wife, husband or civil partner; a brother, sister, parent or

grandchild; the wife, husband or civil partner of a relative; a company under the control of the donor, or under control of connected persons.

11. You understand and accept that itineraries, schedules and accommodation may change and other alterations may occur which are beyond the control of Adventure Café or ShelterBox.
12. ShelterBox shall not be liable for any injury, illness or death of any person or persons nor loss of or damage to any property nor for any indirect or consequential loss however arising.
13. ShelterBox may at its sole discretion change routes or withdraw places on the Event if it is believed to be in its best interest to do so.
14. By signing the enclosed Booking Form you also acknowledge that photographs and written quotations may be taken of you during the Event and used to publicise future events and the work of ShelterBox in general. Please advise us in writing, prior to the Event, if you do not wish for photographs and written quotations to be used.
15. ShelterBox challenges are demanding and will require a good level of fitness, strength and endurance. It is your responsibility to ensure that you have the appropriate level of fitness. If you are in any doubt about your fitness please discuss your concerns with your personal GP. Please do not agree to participate if your GP suggest that you should not be undertaking the challenge.
16. Please ensure you read and complete the medical declaration contained within Adventure Cafe's Booking Form and inform them of any situations that may make completing the Event more risky.
17. ShelterBox will hold your personal data in strict confidence and in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. ShelterBox will only share your personal data with organisations directly involved in the event
